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Guidelines for Paging Groups on Avaya IP Office

Avaya would like to provide the following guidance to help support IP Office installations that require Group Paging to Avaya IP or digital telephones. These guidelines do not apply to paging using external equipment.

IP Offices with large Paging Groups and complex configurations can on occasion cause some system performance degradation during the paging activity. Therefore Avaya recommends the following limits on the number of members that can be configured in a Paging Group are not exceeded. Multiple paging groups can be configured on the IP Office, but each paging group should not exceed these limits.

If a Paging Group limit is exceeded there may on occasion be some system performance degradation, such as slow response on phone displays or voice quality issues. Avaya will not accept escalations for any issues caused by the effect of Paging Groups configured above the recommended limit.
